Permission granted for erection of first floor side extension at Ryors Lodge,
Stibbard Road.

Parish Plan

Letter received from Mrs J Vennell regarding 'Horse Pyghtle', Ryors Lane as
possible Community Land. The Chairman will investigate further.

Finance

A proposal was made for the Parish Council to contribute £400 towards the
upkeep of the Wood Norton Churchyard. A vote was taken with 4 for the
proposal and 1 abstention. Cheque to be signed and given to the Treasurer
of the Parochial Church Council, Jayne Benton.

Parish Notice Board

Quotation for repairs to the Parish Notice Board had been received from Mr
David Gedge Woodworks. The total cost for the repairs will be £377.71
although the Parish Council felt that they would like the posts sunk in crushed
stone/hoggin and a stay on both doors. The Council agreed to proceed with
the work and asked the Clerk to oversee the repairs.
